We know for many of you, due to COVID, this may be your only opportunity to horse show in Minnesota. Stonegate and Tracy Grandstrand will be handling your stabling needs, so please contact her as soon as possible at 651-260-6773 to reserve your stall, as stabling will be limited and will fill quickly.

Due to a late mailing of paper prize lists, the late fee for this horse show will be waived until Schooling Day. Stalls and entries will be limited and, in order to make sure we plan appropriately and ensure you have a stall, please do an early entry as soon as possible:

- Send your <u>Stonegate Summer I Jumper Horse Show entry</u> (required)
- Include your check for your stall and entries (required)
- Include your signed <u>USEF Waiver and Release of Liability</u> (required)

Some information for all entries and trainers...

- Spectators will NOT be admitted onto the show grounds under any circumstances and only one adult may accompany a minor. Please do not send other spectators in the hopes that it will be allowed. Management reserves the right to turn extra spectators away at the gate.
- Masks MUST be worn unless mounted. Social distancing will be expected.
- We will not be offering food service on the horse show grounds.
- Remember that the \$50 late fee will be waived until schooling day and entries are still open. Online entries will close on Friday, July 3.
- We plan to have a credit card option available (for a fee) to close out your bill but it is recommended to send a check to secure your stall and entries.
- Full COVID protocols will be available at least 14-days prior to the horse show. Please see them HERE.
- Filing documents (Coggins, Waivers, Microchip, SafeSport Certification) ahead of time with the Horse Show office will help a great deal.
